

# JMS Products: HOW TO MEASURE AN ENGLISH STYLE SADDLE For CUSTOM ORDERS\*

Use a fabric measuring tape to follow the contours of the saddle in the same places you want the sheepskin to cover.

**SEAT CURVE LENGTH:** Following the CURVE of the seat from front Pommel to back Cantle: \_\_\_\_\_

**SEAT WIDTH:** Measure at the widest part of the seat area where the riders tail bone normally rests; \_\_\_\_\_

**SEAT DEPTH:** Lay a yard stick from the cantle to the front pommel then measure down to the deepest part of the seat area from this straight point. \_\_\_\_\_ inches  
This indicates how much seat curve is needed in the sheepskin.  
Indicate how many inches from the cantle on the yard stick you had to go to drop down to the deepest part. \_\_\_\_\_

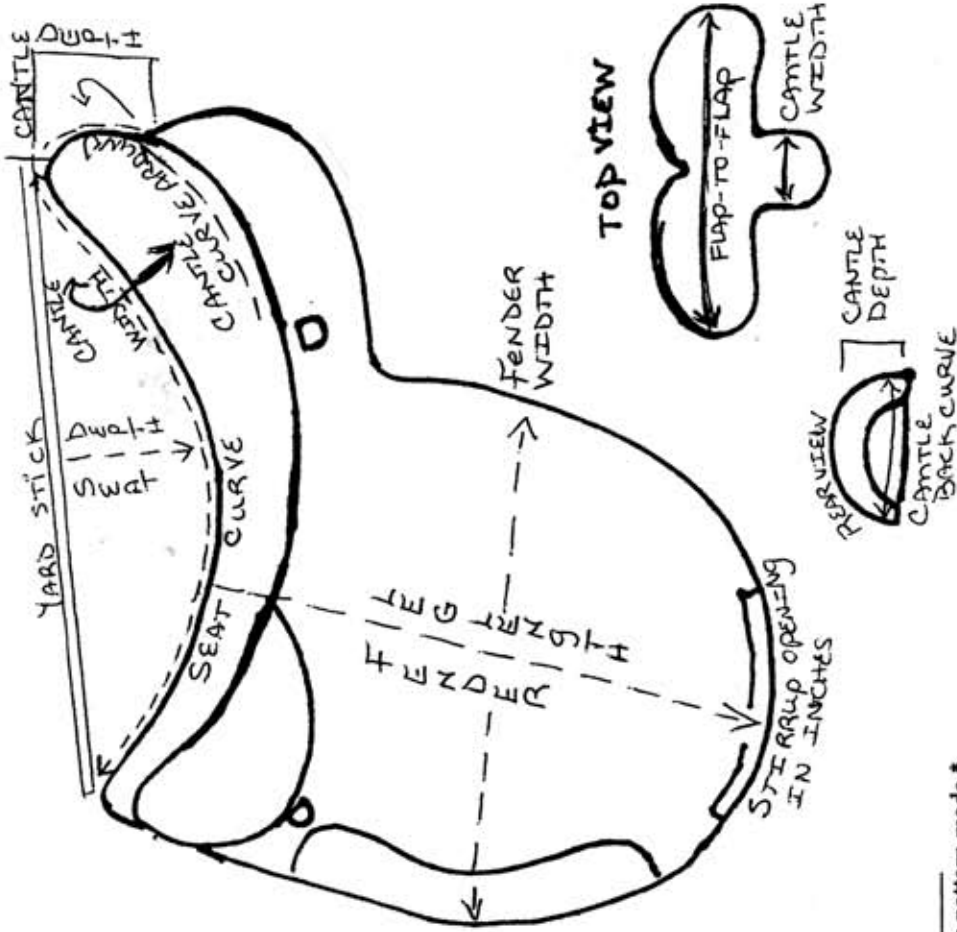
**Rear of CANTLE DEPTH:** Measure the BACK SIDE of the cantle from the top to the skirt. This is to make a rear pocket to hold the sheepskin on to the saddle. \_\_\_\_\_

**REAR of CANTLE BACK CURVE:** Usually there are D-rings on the sides of an English Saddle. Measure around the bottom rear of the Cantle from one-D-Ring to the other. \_\_\_\_\_  
This gives us the LENGTH of the cantle pocket.

**FLAP-to-FLAP:** Measure from one side of saddle (bottom of fender) to other: \_\_\_\_\_

Center of Seat to Bottom of Fender = LEG LENGTH: \_\_\_\_\_

**FLAP WIDTH:** Measure the WIDEST part of the saddle fender/flap. \_\_\_\_\_  
If there are high knee-rolls or other contours involved we will need a plastic pattern made.\*
